### AGM minutes

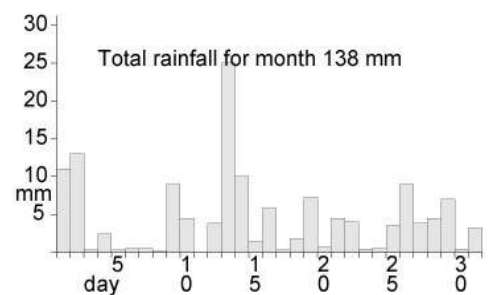
The draft minutes for the Institute Management Committee AGM held on the 11th March can now be seen on Thornton Rust News.
