involve much effort, does it?

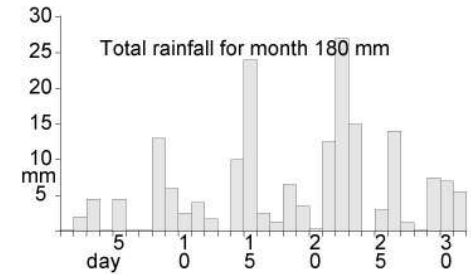
Not true, I'm afraid. Around a

Car parking permits

In the past, annual parking permits
could be purchased from Richmond-
shire District Council. These were
valid for a few car parks within
Richmondshire, including Leyburn
and Hawes.

Now that smaller district councils
form part of North Yorkshire
Council, such permits can be
purchased from NYC. This can be
done online at:
