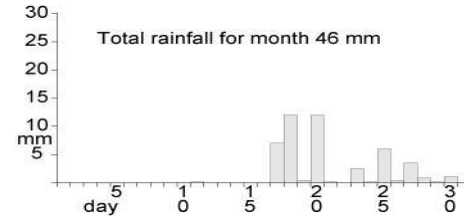
Christian Aid
