Communication

There are three ways in which I can send out your news to the village.

1. Bulletin

The Thornton Rust Bulletin goes out at the start of every month to all villagers on email. Paper copies are also delivered by hand to those who are not on email, and copies are sent by post to some former members of the village living in Bainbridge.

I edit the content of everything sent in. Sometimes details are incorrect, important information may be missing, words may be misspelt.

What you send in to the Bulletin needs to include your name, so that readers can consult you for further information etc. This means that anonymous items are not acceptable. After all, the fact that you are the one generating the item is in itself an important part of the information.

There is no longer any deadline for submissions. I can take items at any time. I can add an extra page, so items need not be trimmed.

2. Bulletin Extra

Sometimes important information needs to be circulated immediately within the month. A Bulletin Extra is sent out by email and paper copies delivered to those not on email. No copies are sent by post.

3. Bulletin Note

This is intended for non-urgent items, such as a repetition of something in the Bulletin, e.g. for a reminder. It is only sent out by email. If you want your Bulletin Note to go out also to those not on email, I can give you a list of the addresses for you to deliver them yourself.

Mid-Summer Dinner

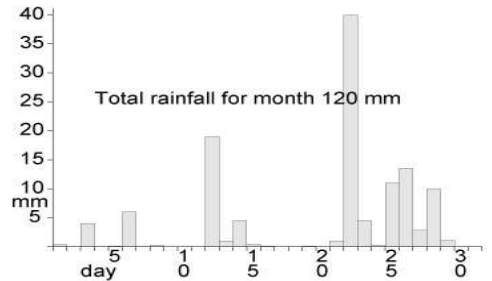
