An Evensong service will be held in the Mission Room on Sunday 25th June at 4 p.m. All welcome. Jackie Cook

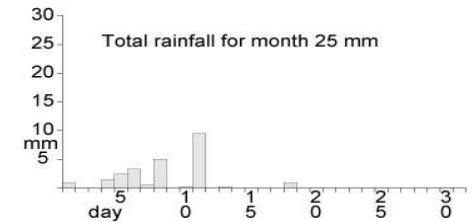
Christian Aid
