- 1. Consideration of Apologies for Absence Apologies were given and accepted from Parish Councillors Jones and Wood and District Councillor Yvonne Peacock
- **2. Minutes of Parish Council meeting held on -** The minutes of Meeting held on 15th February 2024 were approved as a true and correct record

3. Declaration of interest

The Clerk updated that on receipt of the e mails from the Bishopdale resident, she had e mailed the Monitoring Office at NYC to query whether the PC should have received any correspondence from the Council regarding the outcome of the complaint made against Cllr Parker by the Bishopdale resident. (The only documentation the PC has been made aware of following the conclusion of the assessment was an e mail dated 19.12.23 from the Monitoring Office addressed/e mailed to Cllr Parker which Cllr Parker shared with the PC on 05.01.24, minuted at 11.01.24 PC meeting).

The Monitoring Office replied to the Clerk's e mail on 11.03.24 and confirmed that no correspondence had been sent to the Parish Council regarding the outcome of the complaint. The Monitoring Office advised that complaints are treated confidentially and correspondence from the Monitoring Officer is generally only with the subject Member and the Complainant.

A discussion about training took place. The Parish Council are aware of how to access information and training from various sources including North Yorkshire Council and Yorkshire Local Council Association (YLCA). The Parish Council were encouraged to access training which they feel is of benefit to them.

4. Matters arising from the last meeting

Urban grass cutting 24/25

The Clerk read out the e mails received from NYC Highway Asset Management (HAM) in March re Urban grass cutting 24/25. The Parish Council decided not to accept the NYC payment re vis-splays, etc. Action - Clerk to let HAM know.

5. Highways/Street Lights/Bins

Historic Matters

The Clerk explained that she has created a spreadsheet log which she will update with any new items which are not resolved. The spreadsheet will periodically be sent to Highways et al as a reminder of outstanding issues.

Updates from 15.02.24 Meeting

- Water leaking on to B6160 Street Head, Newbiggin The Clerk had not received a response from Highways
 re the request to supply landowner with 60 metres of 12' pipe. Cllr Dinsdale said that the landowner had
 since decided to carry out the work at his own cost.
- Salt/Grit Bin, near Institute, Aysgarth The Clerk updated that Highways had agreed to service the grit bin on a rechargeable (third party funded) basis as the grit would be used on the service road outside the Institute which is within the public maintainable highway. The annual cost to the Parish Council would be £90 including VAT. The Parish Council agreed to the cost. Action Clerk to advise Highways.
- **Church Bank, Aysgarth** District Cllr Peacock had e mailed to confirm that Highways have swept the road, put up signs re skidding and resurfacing works will start in early summer.
- Salt/Grit Bin, outside Candlelight Cottage, Newbiggin no update was available.

Cllr Sayer said that following the alleged damage to the Gill the matter had been referred to North Yorkshire Council.

Cllr Sayer said that she was very upset as she had e mailed the Parish Council Clerk in March about planning matters and had not received a reply or any action. The Clerk said that she had not received the e mail and asked Cllr Sayer to confirm what date she had sent it and to resend it from her sent items so that it could be circulated to the Parish Council.

R/58/77D - Householder planning permission for erection of wooden greenhouse and shed/log store to the rear of the property at South View, Thoralby, DL8 3SU. **The Parish Council had no comment to make.**

R/59/54B - Section 73A application to vary Condition 1 - plans list; and Condition 2ii) window specification of R/59/54A (Section 73A application to vary Condition 2 of R/59/54 (Full planning permission for re-occupation of a former dwelling and installation of package treatment plant) at High Meadow Barn, Thornton Rust DL8 3AW. Cllr Cromey-Hawke explained that the application was approved last year and the only change which is being requested is regarding the windows. The YDNPA had asked for wooden single glazed windows. The applicants have asked for Heritage Approved double glazed UPVC. The Parish Council felt that Heritage approved should be permitted.

8. Thoralby Moss and Thornton Mire (Standing Item)

Annual Declaration/Claim for Stewardship

The Clerk read out the letter received from WBW dated 19.03.24 re Annual Declarations/Claims for Existing Stewardship & Woodland Schemes (close date 16.05.24). The Parish Council agreed that WBW should continue to act as Parish Council agent and make the necessary arrangements. Action - Clerk to confirm to WBW.

• Thoralby Moss Legal matters - The clerk read out the e mail responses from the solicitor dated 25th and 27th March 24.

Cllr Sayer said that there had been a comment made at the Annual Parish meeting that there was no water on Thoralby Moss. Robert Fawcett (Jnr) said that there was standing water but it was not running water. Cllr Sayer asked Robert Fawcett what had happened to the grips. Robert said that they had been filled in as part of the regeneration. Cllr Sayer asked what was the state of the fencing. Robert said it was relatively stock proof.

9. Edwardian Rock Garden, Aysgarth (Standing Item)

Cllr Dinsdale said that there had been a positive write up on the Edwardian Rock Garden in Yorkshire Treasures. Councillors Dinsdale and Windle were thanked for the ongoing gardening and maintenance which they carry out.

10. Annual Parish Meeting Minutes/Action Points (Circulated)

Aysgarth Township - 25.03.24

- **Kelspring** (Between Aysgarth & Thornton Rust) Following various chaser e mails to Highways from the Clerk, the drain had been cleared recently, but a more permanent solution is needed.
- **Harper Wath Ford** Cllr Dinsdale reported that off roaders were using the ford and it was getting churned up. It was agreed that if the road became dangerous it was a Police matter and local residents should call the non-emergency police number.

Thoralby with Newbiggin & Bishopdale - 18.03.24

- A&D PC to contact the solicitor to confirm receipt of a copy of the title agreement for the shooting rights and the side agreement for the Stewardship Fund - The Clerk advised that this had already been done on 13.03.24.
- A&D PC to contact NYC Highways and YDNP to confirm ownership of the land at the North side of Goose Land iron bridge. If ownership cannot be confirmed, quotes to be obtained from Robbie Parker and John Ellerton.
- A&D PC to write a letter to the owner of The Old Corn Mill to ask visitors not to park on the Mill Hill The
 Clerk advised that this has been done previously.
- A&D PC to write a letter to the residents living above the top gate at Blindsyke to ask them to close the gate from May until the middle of November to prevent sheep from escaping It was agreed that it was not for

the Parish Council to write. Robert Fawcett (Jnr) present at the meeting said that he would try and sort it out.

Chris Parker to assess the work involved in fitting the railings at the new Wash Dub Bridge and have a look at Low Green bridge to see if stone from the old Wash Dub bridge could be used to replace the broken wooden slat - Cllr Parker updated that he has looked at it and there would be a cost of circa £180. It was agreed that this would be paid from the Thoralby Moss bank account.

Thornton Rust - 27.03.24

Posts - Cllr Cromey-Hawke reported that the new posts had been delivered but it had been too wet to install
them as the concrete would not have set. A working party to be arranged to paint and install them when the
weather improves.

12. Any Other Business

- Cllr Windle said that there had been a request for the Parish Council to swap rooms with the Sewing Club
 and move upstairs for some of the meetings held in the winter (December April). The cost of the upstairs
 room is more expensive, but the rate would be held at £12 for the Parish Council as there was a dual
 booking.
- Cllr Sayer received an e mail on her phone during the meeting from a Bishopdale resident complaining about the temporary worker's accommodation at Bishopdale as the planning permission had expired on 17.03.24. Councillors said that the YDNPA had already responded directly to the various e mails from the Bishopdale resident (which the Parish Council were copied into).
- BAWB Federation The Clerk said that it had been brought to her attention that there may be plans to temporarily close West Burton School. The Parish Council who had supported the continuation of all three schools in the BAWB Federation were very disappointed and concerned about the effect on the education of children in the Parishes. Action - Clerk to e mail Sue Ryding (Chair of Governors) to express the Parish Councils concerns, to enquire about the consultation process, sparsity funding, and to ask for the Parish Council to be kept informed.
- Pip Pointon said that The Association of Rural Communities (ARC) are sponsoring a public meeting at Leyburn Methodist Church Hall on 30.04.24 at 7.30pm re the health of the River Ure and its tributaries. Alastair Dinsdale, chairperson of ARC will be chairing the meeting. There are concerns about the declining number of fish. The Environment Agency have taken samples. They are hoping to set up a group similar to 'Save Our Swale'. Cllr Dinsdale said that he intends to attend the meeting.
