Updates

- **Drains, Thornton Rust & Bishopdale** Cllr Cromey-Hawke said that Highways had responded to the PC e mail of 26.01.24 quickly and had done an excellent job of hoovering the chambers and using a high-pressure jet on the drains and the drains were now working well. A good job had also been done repairing pot holes on the Aysgarth to Thornton Rust road and the drains in Bishopdale Action Clerk to send thank you e mail and advise that one drain in Bishopdale had been missed.
- Concerns re Gritting Newbiggin and parts of Thoralby The e mail from Mr. Battersby NYC dated 22.01.24 was noted.
- Salt/Grit Bin, near Institute, Aysgarth Cllr Windle had asked the Clerk to ask the Council to refill the bin. The Clerk updated that NYC are not responsible for servicing the bin despite the NYCC Highways sticker.

Neither are they able to service it on a rechargeable (third party funded) basis as the area does not lie within the public maintainable highway. Action - Clerk to e mail Highways with a map of the public maintainable highway.

New Matters from 15.02.24 Meeting

- Water leaking on to B6160 Street Head, Newbiggin Cllr Dinsdale had received a phone call from Mr Parker re water leaking from his field onto the road. Action Clerk to ask Highways if they could supply Mr Parker with 60 metres of 12' pipe as the water was making the road dangerous.
- Salt/Grit Bin, outside Candlelight Cottage, Newbiggin Cllr Jones reported that the bin has also been filling
 with water as the lid does not stay closed. NYC had previously bashed a hole in it with a shovel to drain it and
 consequently the salt also washes through and it is not fit for purpose. Action Clerk to ask if a new bin could
 be provided at no cost to the Parish Council.

6.3 Defibrillator - Action - Clerk to order the defibrillator pads x 2 for Aysgarth & Newbiggin and batteries x 2 for Newbiggin and Thoralby.

7. Planning - To consider the following Planning Applications:

New Applications

R/51/60F - Full planning permission for an operational change to the mixture of unit types allowed on the site, from the current mix of 5 caravan, motorhome or campervan pitches and 10 tent or trailer tent pitches to the proposed mix of up to 10 caravan, motorhome and campervan pitches in addition to up to 10 tent or trailer tent pitches. The number of pitches available for use at any one time would remain at a maximum of 15, the change would allow the combination of pitches to flex between a mix of accommodation types on those pitches at Town Ends, Aysgarth, DL8 3AQ (close date for PC comments extended from 30.01.24 to 16.02.24). **The Parish Council agreed to support the change of use.** Action - Clerk to e mail YDNPA.

R/57/47B - Householder planning permission for erection of wooden summer house at Whitbeck, Newbiggin, DL8 3TD. **The Parish Council had no comment to make.**

R/54/7W - Full planning permission for use of land for siting of caravan for use as holiday park reception and office and site wide lighting plan (retrospective) at Aysgarth Lodge Holidays, Westholme Bank, Aysgarth. **The Parish Council discussed the concerns previously made re lighting levels etc.**

Action - Clerk to e mail YDNPA stating that further to previous objection made by the Parish Council, the lighting must remain consistent with the Yorkshire Dales National Park Dark Skies. There are concerns that the technical paint will wear off and the Parish Council feel there should be an enforced maintenance routine to ensure the light emitted does not revert back to white light.

- Portrait of His Majesty The King The Clerk read out an e mail received after the agenda was issued from NYC dated 13.02.24 re free framed portrait for Parish Councils. Action - Clerk to register and order a portrait.

 representative from the Health Authority would be attending to talk about the new Medical Centre planned
 for Catterick.
- Storm Damage, Newbiggin Cllr Jones said that during the storms in December 23 a telegraph pole next to the BT Telephone Box in Newbiggin had blown down causing damage to the sheep dip, wash area and wall. This was reported to BT Open Reach in December and January 24 and they came out, took the wires down and put an order in for a new pole and for the wall to be repaired. The BT phone box is now out of order. The phone is needed due to poor mobile phone signal in the area. Action Cllr Jones to chase BT Open Reach again and obtain case reference number and e mail address so that Clerk can follow it up if needed.
