# Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2022 At Aysgarth Institute at 7.30pm

- 1. Consideration of Apologies for Absence Apologies were given and accepted from Parish Councillor Wood
- **2. Minutes of Parish Council meeting held on -** The minutes of Meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2022 were approved as a true and correct record

### Sunday Dales Bus 856 - Ruth Annison

Ruth Annison summarised to the meeting that Upper Wensleydale has a bus service which enables residents to get to and from work in Hawes each day, but not to Leyburn where there are more job opportunities. It is the only bus service running from Northallerton to Hawes and back and so provided residents with the ability once a week to connect with the railway station or to visit those in hospital. It was also part of a network providing connections to Teeside, Darlington, Preston and other locations. She believed that the weekly Dales Bus service was just about enough, except that residents could not use it to get to work in Leyburn.

Ruth explained that she is not connected to the bus service other than being a supporter. The bus service is run by a devoted group of volunteers who are very professional. She said the Sunday Dales bus service was unusual because it does not receive funding either from the government or North Yorkshire County Council (Cllr Peacock has supported with the Locality Budget). The Passenger Survey has demonstrated that the service is well used by local residents and visitors up and down the dale. Income is generated from fares and refunds via Country Council re Senior Citizen Passes and fares from other areas honoured by the County Council plus much needed fund raising.

Ruth asked if there were any questions. Cllr Cromey-Hawke said that a potential avenue for additional funding is the National Lottery People & Places Small and Medium Grant for Community Projects which is open to the whole of the UK. The web address was provided to Ruth.

The Parish Council thanked Ruth.

#### 5. Highways/Street Lights/Bins

#### Historic

- Bridge at Bishopdale Cllr Peacock will be arranging an informal meeting with Highways and the Parish Council at the YDNPA offices where Highways can show the technical details. She hopes the work will commence in the Summer of 2023.
- Spickles Lane, Aysgarth & Burton-Cum-Walden Cllr Peacock confirmed that the lane will be resurfaced
- Mill Lane, Aysgarth Cllr Peacock updated that Steve Barker has confirmed that the works are on the list

#### From 06.10.22 Parish Council Meeting

- Historic problem of phone cable tangled in dangerous tree deteriorated at High Gill, Low Gill, Thornton Rust Rd - Highways had said for the Parish Council to contact BT. Cllr Cromey-Hawke had contacted BT and received a standard response re 14-day timeframe. Action - Cllr Peacock will follow this up with Highways as it is not what was originally advised to Cllr Peacock/Cllr Dinsdale during the site visit.

- -The full planning application for the new dwelling at the site of the temporary accommodation should have been submitted and approved before due consideration to the need for this extension be applied for
